What does the Fund invest in?


The Fund is designed to achieve long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in equity securities of large capitalization issuers. The portfolio may consist of all types of equity and debt obligations of issuers in Canada that are listed for trading upon the facilities of stock exchanges or other organized and regulated trading facilities in Canada. Assets of the Fund may also be invested in debt obligations or held in cash to the extent that economic, market or other conditions make it appropriate. The Fund is classified as a Canadian Equity fund thus, it must invest at least 90% of its equity holdings in securities domiciled in Canada.

The charts below give you a snapshot of the Fund's investments on June 30, 2018. The Fund's investments will change.

How risky is it?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund’s returns change over time. This is called “volatility.”

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

Risk rating

NCM Asset Management Ltd. has rated the volatility of this Fund as **low to medium**.

This rating is based on how much the Fund’s returns have changed from year to year. It doesn’t tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.

No guarantees

Like most mutual funds, this Fund doesn’t have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

How has the Fund performed?

This section tells you how Series R shares of the Fund have performed over the past calendar year. Returns are after expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund’s returns.

Who is this Fund for?

This Fund is suitable for investors who:

- Wish to invest primarily in Canadian large capitalization equities
- Are interested in a quantitative investment style with a value overlay
- Are comfortable with low to medium investment risk (i.e. are willing to accept some fluctuation in the market value of your investment)
- This series is only available for purchase by the NCM Funds and other funds and accounts managed or advised by the Manager and/or its affiliates and are not available for public purchase.

A word about tax

In general, you’ll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the fund in a registered plan such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your fund in a non-registered account, fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series R shares of the Fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales charges

No sales charges or commissions are applicable to this series of the Fund.

2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the Fund's return. The Fund's expenses are made up of the operating expenses and trading costs. There are no management fees payable in respect of Series R shares of the fund. Because this series of the fund is new, operating expenses and trading costs are not yet available.

More about the trailing commission

No trailing commission is paid in respect of this series of the Fund.

3. Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch shares of the Fund.

Fee	What you pay
Short-term redemption fee	2% of the cost of the shares you redeem within 90 days of the original date of purchase. This fee is charged by the Manager.
Switch fee	Your representative's firm may charge you a fee if you switch to another series of the Fund or to another fund within the NCM Group of Funds.

What if I change my mind?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- Withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual funds within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- Cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase or, in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory.
